

Service Connection/Disconnection Program

MWS has a written procedure for new service connections and for service disconnections. The procedure for tapping into the collection system is outlined in "Guide to New Construction," available on the website:

MWS will perform the sewer tap on existing public mains. For private mains, prior to deeding to MWS, a Licensed municipal utility contractor or licensed master plumber may follow the "Tap Policy" as described in the guide, to tap their own mains for service to their new lots only. MWS also has standard requirements and construction details available on their website:

After the installation of a new service connection, MWS performs a pressure test on the service line and main. As-built plans for the new sewer connection "tee" location must be submitted to MWS in digital and hard copy form
